Christ Church Academy are proud of our smart and distinctive uniform which helps to instil a sense of community and belonging for the pupils, and a sense of loyalty to the Academy.



THE ACADEMY UNIFORM:

- Official CCA branded blazer (see note 1)
- White shirt for all year groups (see note 2)
- CCA school tie (KS2 – blue, KS3 - red) (see note 3)
- Grey skirt **NOT BLACK** (see note 4) or
- Grey tailored trousers/shorts **NOT BLACK** (see note 5)
- Unbranded plain black or grey socks or black tights (*no white/sport/logo socks allowed*)
- Black shoes (see 'footwear' section)



THE ACADEMY PE KIT:

- CCA branded t-shirt
- CCA navy/red shorts or unbranded navy shorts/skort
- Navy unbranded PE socks
- PE Trainers (any colour)

The following items are optional:

- CCA branded hoodie or unbranded navy hoodie (plain) or
- CCA branded base-layer (new from Sept 2025)
- Navy unbranded tracksuit bottoms or leggings



The following items will be needed at a later date:

- Y6 swimming costume/trunks – when advised.
- Y7/Y8 gum shields will be needed - when advised.
- Boots/shin pads – dates will be confirmed a month in advance. Please note that in school we run a 'boot swap' scheme so you could swap a pair worn in Year 5 for some which will fit later on!).

Uniform Notes

1. **The blazer needs to be the official CCA blazer** (navy with red trim) which includes the Academy badge - available from our stockists.
2. **Shirts must be white** and have a collar with a top button which should be properly fastened. They should not be fitted. Shirts should be tucked in at all times.
3. Years 5 and 6 wear a blue **tie**, Years 7 and 8 wear a red **tie**. Ties are only available to purchase directly from school (£4 card only).
4. **All skirts must be grey NOT BLACK**, knee length. Long 'maxi' skirts, tight 'tube' skirts and 'skater-style' skirts are not permitted.
5. **All trousers and shorts must be grey NOT BLACK**, of an appropriate tailored style, and not tight fitting or 'skinny fit'. Styles such as cargo, cords, jeans, canvas or jeggings, are not permitted. Trousers and shorts must not have any leg pockets. Shorts must be knee length. If a belt is worn, it must be black.

Items of uniform which do not display our logo can be purchased from any shop if they comply with our requirements.

Footwear

Additional information and photos can be seen on the back of this leaflet

All pupils should wear flat black shoes (not boots) which are fully enclosed and can be polished. Canvas, suede or trainer shoes are not permitted. There should be no colours, nor should they feature any logos or motifs. Footwear such as Nike, Adidas, Vans or Converse (in any material) are not allowed to be worn as school shoes.

If trainers or other unsuitable footwear are worn to school, alternative footwear will be provided for the day.

Personal Appearance - Hair, Make Up and Jewellery

Hair should be of a natural colour, and be kept smart and tidy. Haircuts should be a minimum of a number 2 grade cut. Fashion haircuts, such as steps, lines and shaved styles are not allowed. In certain lessons, long hair must be tied back for safety reasons. Large bows, slides, flowers or other similar fashion accessories are not permitted.


No jewellery should be worn, except a simple wrist watch. Smart watches should not be worn. Any watches/devices that cause a distraction or are inappropriately used during school hours will be confiscated.

Earrings - pupils are allowed to wear a single gold or silver small stud in each ear lobe – these must be removed for PE lessons. Ear lobe spacers are not permitted to be worn in school. No other types of piercing are allowed.

Any jewellery worn in school will be confiscated and can be collected at the end of the day.

Pin Badges – only pin badges issued by the school can be worn on the school blazer.

Make-up, false lashes/false nails and nail varnish are not permitted at any time. Any pupils wearing make-up or nail varnish will be provided with appropriate remover within school. If they are wearing false nails/extensions/gel nails the school will contact home and ask for them to be removed that evening. If the pupil continues to wear false nails, they will lose their social time in school. False eyelashes are not allowed. Those wearing false eyelashes will be directed to remove them and will lose their social time.



No footwear/clothing is to be worn with sports brand logos – ie Nike, Adidas etc. Several stockists are marketing them as “back to school” however, these are **not allowed** at the Academy.
