SCHOOL LUNCH PAYMENTS

Please can we ask that you check your balance on ParentPay on a regular basis and clear all debts as soon as possible. Moving forward, if your balance reaches **£20.00** in debt, we will no longer be able to offer a hot dinner and you will have to make alternative arrangements. The ladies in the office work hard to keep parents informed but we ask that you also check your balances as we cannot sustain the debt.

JEWELLERY

Polite reminder that jewellery is not permitted in school. The only exception is a small wrist watch and stud earrings.

All earrings have to be removed for PE and swimming so consider this if you think about getting your child's ears pierced as they will have to miss PE lessons if they cannot removed them.

NUT-FREE

Please note that Christ Church is a nut free school

We have a number of children in school with serious nut allergies. The school kitchen is nut-free and we need to ensure that children do not bring any foods that contain nuts into school. This includes chocolate spread sandwiches. Please check the labels on any foods that you pack in a lunch box and find alternatives if items contain any type of nut.

We need to safeguard the children in our care.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please support us in ensuring that the children are wearing correct school uniform and that they have **a jumper and a coat** in school. We sell the uniform at cost price in school to keep costs as low as possible and you can also purchase plain jumpers and polo shirts.

In Key Stage 2, children should all wear a white school shirt and a tie.

PE kit is a navy t-shirt and black or navy shorts/skorts.

In colder weather, children may wear a plain navy or black tracksuit or a sweatshirt and leggings. Please support us by following the school uniform rules.
