Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to begin by thanking you for your continued support in helping us maintain the high standards of behaviour and uniform that we expect at our school. Your cooperation plays a vital role in ensuring that students present themselves with pride and are ready to learn each day.

I would also like to remind families about a few key expectations. Mobile phones should not be used at any time while students are on the school site. In our experience, phones often cause more disruption than benefit during the school day. Please be assured that if we ever need to contact you, we have your details and will do so promptly through the appropriate channels.

In line with our uniform policy, jewellery should not be worn, with the exception of one pair of plain stud earrings, one in each ear. This helps us maintain consistency and ensures the safety of all students.

Please also note that fizzy and energy drinks are not permitted on site, as part of our commitment to promoting healthy choices.

Finally, I would like to emphasise the serious dangers associated with vaping. Should a student be suspected of vaping or found to be carrying a vape, there will be severe sanctions in line with our behaviour policy. We take this matter very seriously in order to protect the health and wellbeing of all students.
