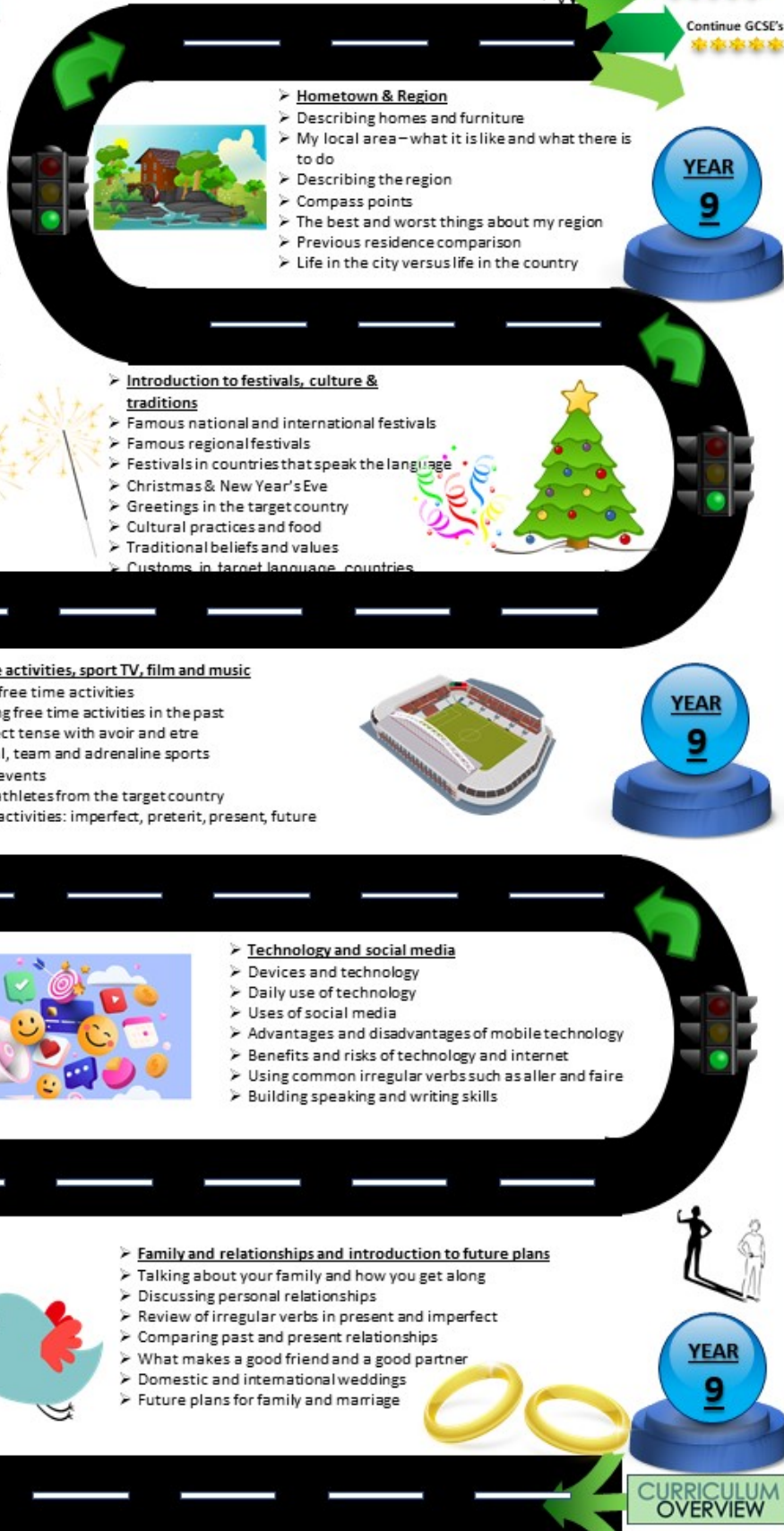
Year 9 Survival Top Tips
