


YOUR ADOBE CREATIVE CLOUD AT-HOME ACCESS IS READY




DOWNLOAD AND INSTALL CREATIVE CLOUD APPS

Follow the instructions below to download, install, and access Creative Cloud Desktop apps on your computer.

1. Sign in to the [Creative Cloud website](#) using your school account (username@churchmead.org).




2. If prompted, select **Company or School Account** and then enter your password.




Note:

You will see the Office 365 sign in page. Sign in with your school e-mail and password.

3. To view all apps, click **Apps** on top of the page.



4. Click **Install** for the app you want to download. Then follow the onscreen instructions to complete the installation.
