Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award



The Duke of Edinburgh Award, founded by the late Prince Philip in 1957, involves a set of challenges for young people to help their community and environment, increase fitness, develop new skills and complete an independent outdoors expedition. It is a voluntary, non-competitive and flexible programme of cultural and adventurous activities.



Our first group of 19 students, making up three teams, have spent the past six months planning, and training to complete a two day (one night) outdoor expedition which took place around Gerrards Cross in May, plus three months of volunteering and improving a skill.



The weekend involved orienteering, setting up their own tents, working as a team, planning meals and cooking them on camping stoves and hiking, all without the use of electronics.

Engineering wins at BCA competition



Congratulations to all three of our teams from Years 9 and 10 who took part in the Newbury District Agricultural Society Design Make and Market Challenge. We are so proud to announce that Churchmead took 1st, 2nd and 3rd place!

1st place: Agricultural Vision - created a reverse filtration device to use in flood areas to prevent flooding fields for farmers which can lead to lower yields and loss of income
