

During the first week in May we adjusted our theme of the week and our collective worship routine to celebrate the Coronation.


In addition, there was an afternoon for staff and we had a Red, White and Blue day.

Windsor Great Park Estate Open Day

On Wednesday 24th May a group of Year 7 pupils went to see how Windsor Great Park is maintained at the annual Crown Estate Open Day. The day included activities and talks about each department at the Crown Estate. The Forestry and Arboriculture Teams demonstrated moving timber around with the timber trailer and tractor and with heavy horses pulling timber. Our pupils had a go at a speed litter picking challenge, followed by a discussion and practical recycling exercise. They also took part in a nature bingo activity that was a fun half an hour walk through the woods looking at key parts of the bio diversity of the forest. The plumbing department of the Estate had a 'plumbing wall', which allowed our students to follow the passage of water as it works its way through a series of obstacles. Pupils really enjoyed this section which also included helping to tile a roof and putting a window.



