Churchmead celebrates best ever GCSE results!

Churchmead School celebrated a fantastic set of GCSE results in August.

The school maintained very good results in English and Maths, achieving over 73% and 66% 'good passes' respectively, with many outstanding grades in both subjects. A continuing upward trajectory in key subjects, including Science, paints a very encouraging picture as results show a significant improvement on previous years.

Humanities subjects continue to flourish with excellent outcomes in Geography, RE, Spanish and other languages.

Churchmead School takes exceptional pride in the artistic talents of their students, which shone through in the Photography, Art and Drama results.

Vocational subjects including Enterprise have produced some exceptional outcomes, showcasing some of the very talented young people in the cohort.

New subjects, introduced to the curriculum this year, have proven to be exceptionally popular with excellent results evident, particularly in GCSE Business Studies.

Special mention must be given to some of the highest achievers this year, including Anjishnu Roy Choudhury on achieving 10 grade 9's, and Nikola Czarnulicz on achieving three grade 9's, three grade 8's and four grade 7's.



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Volunteering in Kenya



During the summer, some of our Staff and Year 12 students embarked on a trip of a lifetime to volunteer in Kenya for nine days. They were able to visit the elephant orphanage before starting five days volunteering at the Jubilee Primary School in Nakuru. This is in an area where many families and children still live in poverty.







Our students spent time working with students and helping with the construction of a new kitchen for the school. Many were moved to tears with how amazing the children and staff were. We held a sports day and special mini party of treats for the students, who were thrilled with the popcorn, crisps and biscuits. It was a day where stronger bonds were formed and our Churchmead students were a real credit to us. All 71 students were gifted with clothes and toiletries to take home, along with five families, most in need in the slums, who were gifted food bags. Although the poverty was incredibly difficult to see, it was an eye opening experience and we were all reminded how blessed we are. Our students exhibited our school values and have returned feeling very blessed. It was an incredibly emotional day saying goodbye but we all feel very lucky to have been able to meet such special and inspiring people there.



This has truly been a life changing experience. Thank you to the staff who supported the students on this journey. We may have left Kenya, but Kenya will never leave us.

Olympian Tom Dean opens new gym



We were delighted to welcome three times Olympic gold medalist, Tom Dean, to Churchmead last week, as he officially opened our new gym facility. He gave a fantastic inspirational talk to our students with future aspirations of being Olympians themselves, and had his photo taken with them and the gold medals from Tokyo 2020 and Paris 2024. 
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



It's quick and easy to apply for Free School Meals.



Your child will be eligible for Free School Meals if you get any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment & Support Allowance
- Support under V1 of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of state pension credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,900
- Working Tax Credit "run on" the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credits
