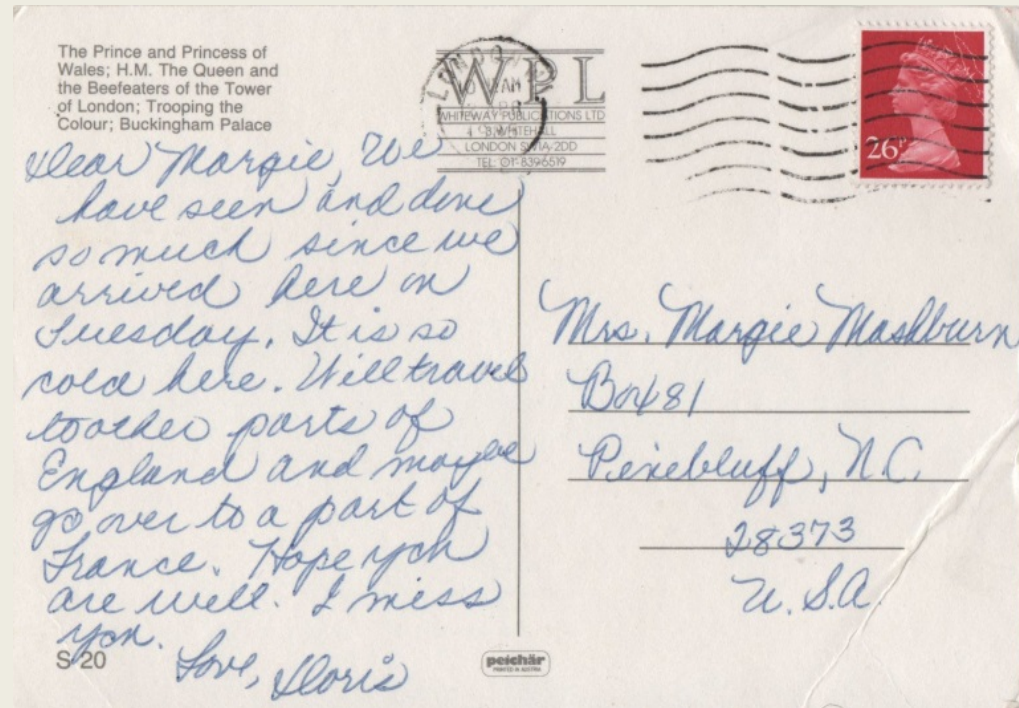
# What do we already know about the 6 Principles of Islam?

2. Belief in angels
3. Belief in the holy books
4. Belief in the Prophets - Muhammad (peace be upon him) is the final prophet.
5. Belief in the Day of Judgement
6. Belief in Predestination

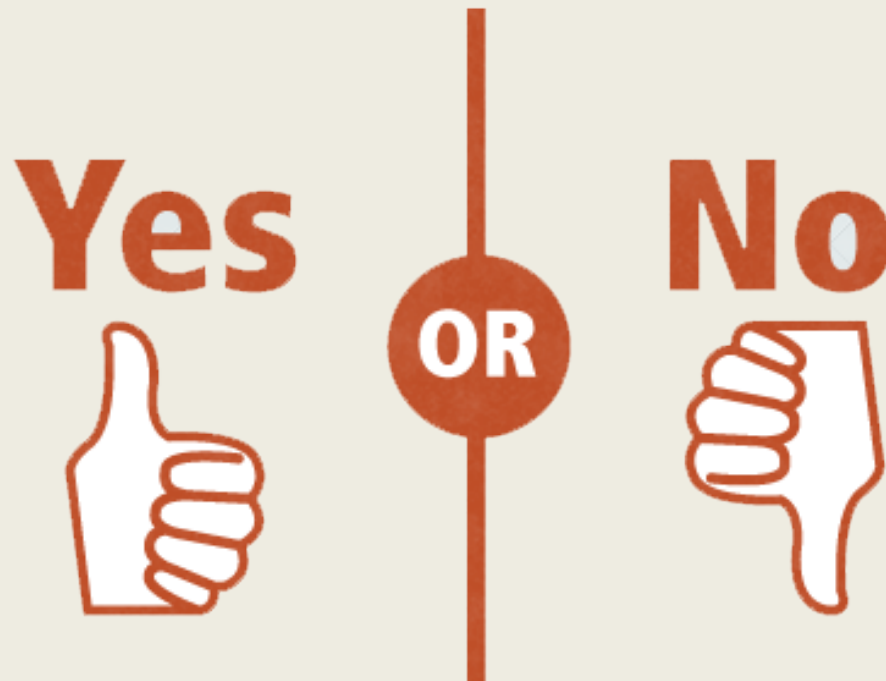

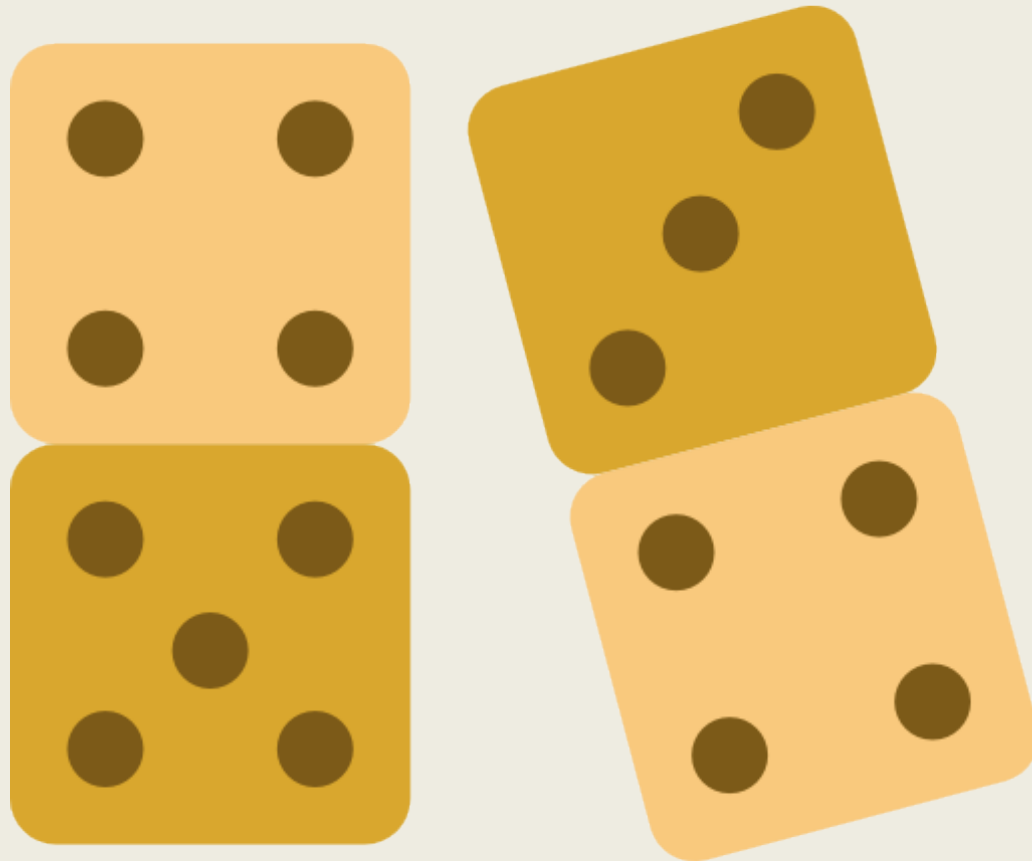
