'Imagine That!' - Year 1 Educational Visit

For Year 1's Educational Visit this year, the children will have the opportunity to visit 'Imagine That!', Liverpool's Science and Discovery centre for children, on Wednesday 22nd March. The purpose of the trip is to support and enhance the children's understanding and experiences of the Science curriculum and the world around us.

Whilst there, the children will participate in a variety of Science workshops led by Imagine That! staff, before being provided with opportunities to explore the 'Imagination Village' and 'Outdoor Area'.

We will be leaving school at **9.00 am**, following normal registration, and hope to return to school at approximately **3.00 pm.** If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they take any necessary medication prior to arriving at school, as staff are unable to administer medication.

The cost for the visit is <u>**£8.50**</u>, which has kindly been subsidised by the PTA in order to keep the costs to a minimum. This includes the cost of the coach, entry fee to 'Imagine That!' and the workshops that the children will experience!

Educational Visits / Trips Terms and Conditions

Payments (if applicable)

All payments are non-refundable. If a student decides not to participate in a reserved visit / trip, cancellation will only be accepted in writing from the parent/carer. The Academy will endeavour to fill places that become available with a suitable replacement but this cannot be guaranteed. If there are insufficient numbers for a trip to go ahead then the trip will be cancelled.

Deposits collected for visits are done so according to the tour operator or booking agencies regulations and are therefore non-refundable in most cases. The terms and conditions of the Tour Operator or Agent will apply.

In the event of the trip being oversubscribed, we will allocate places on a "first come, first served" basis.

All visits based on particular curriculum subjects and necessary to follow the course are funded on a voluntary contributions basis. These contributions are required in order for trips to run. If you have financial difficulties please do not hesitate to contact the school to discuss further.

Any visit deemed to be a reward trip or not essential to following the curriculum has to be paid for in full.

Behaviour
