Dear Parents/Guardians.

KidSafe UK is a PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education) curriculum resource used throughout primary schools in the UK and we will be starting to use this to support our PSHE teaching within KS2. We will initially be utilising the resource to supplement our PSHE curriculum offer in Year 3.

All work is done in an age appropriate and engaging way through a variety of media including the use of a puppet, games, and worksheets.

The KidSafe programme deals with building children's confidence and self esteem and equips them with effective skills to deal with unsafe situations. KidSafe enables children to value themselves and others, and helps them to make wise and healthy choices in their lives.

Given the everchanging landscape of modern society and the different ways we communicate, it is improtant we equip children with the skills and knowledge to navigate a range of situations & this includes teaching children about the different types of abuse and ways to help prevent this in the first place.

Topics covered as part of the KidSafe programme include: Raising self confidence; feelings and talking about our feelings; bullying; respecting our bodies; inappropriate touch; secrets; communication skills; assertion – saying No; computer/internet safety; age ratings; how it feels to hear arguing; looking after our mental health and emotional well-being.

Year 3 parents/guardians are invited to attend our KidSafe information session on Wednesday 6th March which will begin promptly at 2:45pm until 3.10pm in the Old Hall.
