It comments positively on the improvements in the provision for SEND and the impact of the training and processes put in place for our children in school with additional needs.

The report also acknowledges the significant amount of work that has been done in recent years to develop the curriculum and associated assessment processes to meet the new expectations for primary schools.

The areas for the school to improve will form part of the new School Improvement Plan which will be put in place in the Autumn term. The third key area on the plan, which isn't mentioned in the report, but which is very important to us, is to develop more effective communication. Parental surveys have given us areas which we would like to develop and there will be a further survey from the CEO which will give another opportunity to provide feedback in this area.
