Dear Parent/Guardian,

During the week commencing **Monday 17th March, Y5 and Y6** will be taking part in a block week of lessons regarding Relationships, Health and Sex Education. The aim of the sessions is to give the children a better understanding of the changes in puberty, both physically and emotionally, with opportunities for discussion with teachers and peers in mixed gender groups. The content will be approached sensitively with regards to the age and maturity of the pupils. We have made some updates to our sessions which we feel reflect exactly what the children need to know before they leave our school.

The scheme of work will be delivered as part of the statutory Science National Curriculum - which all children will take part in - and the non-statutory PSHE lessons. As a parent/guardian you have a legal right to withdraw your child from the PSHE element of the SRE curriculum. If we do not hear from you, we will assume that you are willing for your child to take part in this scheme of work. If you would like to remove your child from the PSHE sessions, including watching the videos, please inform your child's class teacher by Friday 14th March 2025.

Below is an outline of the topics that will be covered (Science elements are in bold and are statutory):

Y5 Science 2	Describe the life process of reproduction in some plant and animals	Y6 Science 2	Pregnancy: growth of a baby, birth
Y5 PSHE 1	Puberty video (in single sex groups)	Y6 PSHE 1	Puberty video
Y5 PSHE 2 & 3	Personal hygiene and emotions (mixed groups)	Y6 PSHE 2	Adults and children's views on healthy relationships
Y5 PSHE 4 & 5	Adults and children's views on healthy relationships (mixed groups)	Y6 PSHE 3	Conception video (looking at how a child is conceived)
		Y6 PSHE 4	Male and female reproductive systems

During all of these sessions we constantly discuss the importance of empathy, physical and emotional wellbeing and having the rights over our own bodies.
