Dear Parents/Carers of Year 5 Children
Re: Year 6 Residential Trip

Following on from the success of this year’s Robinwood trip with our Year 6 pupils, we are delighted that we are be able to provide this opportunity for our next cohort of Year 6 pupils during the next academic year (2024-2025).

We will once again be visiting the custom-built Robinwood centre at Maes-y-Nant in Wrexham. Set in the beautiful Welsh countryside just outside of Wrexham, the original building dates back to the late Victorian era when it was built as a private house in around 1870. As their newest centre every element of the operation benefits from their experiences over years of operation and feedback across all Robinwood centres. There are indoor facilities for Archery, Climbing, Caving, Piranha Pool, Dungeon and Quest themed Problem Solving. Activities within the grounds include an 80 metre Zip Wire, Giant Swing, Obstacle Course, Night Line and Problem Solving. There is also a custom-built shallow lake, which provides a perfect location for canoeing and raft building in sheltered water.

The residential will take place from **Wednesday 25th September until Friday 27th September 2024**. The approximate cost of the trip will be **£350** which includes travel, insurance, food, accommodation, all activities and the use of waterproofs (based on at least 66 children attending). This price may change if we have more families express an interest in their child attending the residential. Payments for the trip can be made in instalments over the remainder of the academic year via the ParentPay app.

In order to secure a place on the residential, please complete the reply slip below as soon as possible. Numbers are limited and therefore places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The closing date to return the reply slip is **Tuesday 31st October 2023**. A separate letter will be sent to confirm your place with information regarding the deposit payment (£25 deposit based on at least 66 children attending) and further payment options. If you would like your child to take part in the residential but would be unable to meet the full cost, please contact the school office as soon as possible to discuss the matter.
