Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Wraparound Care

Firstly, it is exceptionally important to thank Fun 4 Kidz for the service they have provided for our children and their families over the past nine years at Churchtown Primary School. From the outset, we were extremely pleased when they wanted to start their service with us due to their excellent reputation and over the years our partnership has gone from strength to strength. Staff at the club have worked with the school to ensure a consistent approach and the children have built good relationships with all Fun 4 Kidz staff, displaying fun and enjoyment whilst accessing the afterschool and holiday club.

As you may be aware, we have successfully provided school-led after school care provision for our Nursery and Reception children called 'Little Buds'. Since its creation, the club has had excellent feedback from parents/guardians. Following on from this, we proposed to our trust (Endeavour Learning Trust) that we could offer this service to the rest of the school. The trust agreed, and have supported the school in this transition to bring the whole of the wraparound care under the school's umbrella. We are now excited to be able to offer this full service of breakfast club, after school club and holiday club from the beginning of the Autumn term 2024, to all children aged 2-11 years, for 51 weeks of the school year. This new service will be called 'Butterflies Wraparound Care'.

Before we break up for the summer, we will be sending out more information about the service including hours and prices, which will be very similar to what Fun 4 Kidz currently offer. Our wraparound care provision, Butterflies, will provide a safe and engaging environment for the children at Churchtown whose families require wraparound care support. A wide range of activities will be available each day, including: crafts, games and outdoor play. The provision will also provide a chance for children to spend further time with their friends. All staff will be highly qualified, with relevant ratio and suitable staffing requirements adhered to. As the year progresses, we will be looking to develop this service further to bring in wider expertise to the service, for example utilising sports coaches as part of the provision. Community feedback will also help to develop this service further.



Finally, thank you again to Fun 4 Kidz for their care and attention to the Churchtown families and we wish them well for their continued service in their other settings.
