



PUNCTUALITY!

We would like to politely remind everyone that the school doors open at 8.40am and that children are expected to be in their classrooms by

8.50am for registration. The table below shows what a negative impact poor punctuality can have on a child's education.

Minutes late per day during the school year	Equal days' worth of teaching lost in a year
5 minutes	3.4 days
10 minutes	6.9 days
15 minutes	10.3 days
20 minutes	13.8 days
30 minutes	20.7 days

Core curriculum subjects are normally taught at the start of the day so it is important that children arrive on time to avoid missing key information.


