1st Place – Year 3 (97.3%) - awarded 2 points 2nd Place – Year 6 (96.42%) – awarded 1 point






BUDDY ASSEMBLY GROUPS

National Storytelling Week 😂





SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL VACANCY


Sefton Borough Council's excellent School Crossing Service is currently looking to recruit people to become School Crossing Patrols and School Crossing Standby Patrols.
