Snowdrops will offer year-round provision, available for 51 weeks per year.

IMPORTANT SCHOOL LUNCH INFORMATION FOR CURRENT YEAR 2 CHILDREN, MOVING UP TO YEAR 3 IN SEPTEMBER 2024

Once your child is in Year 3, they will **no longer** be entitled to free school meals. Parents will need to use ParentPay to pay for school lunches, as we operate a cashless cafeteria. A school lunch costs £2.35 per day. The children will be able to choose either a hot meal, deli option, or if they prefer they can bring a packed lunch.

Our fantastic menu and relevant allergen information can be found on our <u>school website</u>. We try to ensure that children eat a balanced diet, and we would appreciate your influence on your child with regard to sensible choices.
