INFORMATION FOR SEPTEMBER 2024: Going home arrangements for <u>NEW</u> Year 5 and Year 6 Children

As your child moves from Year 4 and 5 into Year 5 and 6, it is important that their collection arrangements are recorded and shared with their new class teachers.

Please complete this form to provide information as to how your child will return home at the end of the school day. This will either be a collection from school in the playground by their parents/named contact or your child will make their own way home.

Year 5 and 6 children may be released from the school at the end of the day to make their own way to the boundaries of the school to meet their parents at an allocated place or walk home alone. This is for parents and families to decide but in order for children to do this, written permission must be given.

Parents should be aware that if they give permission for their children to walk to the boundary of school or home, school staff will release children at 3.20pm and it will be parental responsibility from this time to ensure that children are safeguarded.




