Criteria for admissions

<p>Criteria for admissions: Children will be admitted to Nursery under the following criteria.</p> <p>1st priority- Looked after children. This is a child who is in the care of the local authority.</p> <p>2nd priority- Applicants who have a sibling already at Churchtown</p> <p>3rd priority-Places will be offered on a first come first served basis for children turning 4 during the nursery academic year</p> <p>4th priority – places will be offered to children following their third birthday, using the criteria above.</p> <p>5th priority -Following the allocation of places as above and where we have further availability of sessions, parents will be offered to reserve a place for their child before their child's 15 hour universal offer begins on a termly basis or they may pay for sessions.</p>	<p>Reservations will not be taken for the summer term until children eligible to start in the spring term have been offered the facility to reserve a place. Forms may be submitted the September following the child's birth. Any forms received prior to this will be dated September.</p> <p>Forms received after 15th January, prior to the child starting in the September will be classed as a <u>late application</u>.</p> <p>Completion of this form is not a guarantee that your child will receive a place.</p>
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
