

RE

1. Produce a short film about Sikhism—what is it? How do Sikhs worship and what are their main beliefs and expression?
2. Create a PowerPoint explaining how Hindus show their commitment to God. Produce fact cards on the different accounts of the Christmas story.

Science

1. Create your own game of top trumps using facts about the planets. Use paper mâché over balloons to show the relative sizes of the Earth and Sun.
2. Create a poster about the different life processes. Produce fact cards about different animals life cycles.

PSHE

1. Being Me in My World— research different countries across the world and examine how far their rights are met compared to yours?
2. Celebrating difference— compare different cultures across the world. What's the same and what's different? Create a poster raising the awareness of bullying. What can you do if you know it's taking place?

Maths

1. Go on a Negative Number hunt— where can you spot them around your home? Create a Negative Number poster to explain what these are and where we see them.
2. Create a “Steps to Success” leaflet for Year 4 or 5 children on how to complete each of the four operations. Create your own multi-step worded problems (which you must know the answer to)
3. Test your parents and carers with made-up addition and subtraction questions. If they can't complete them correctly, teach them how to be successful

1. Research human rights - learn about adult and children rights.
2. Create a fact file about the importance of human rights.



The Arts

1. Watercolour painting: Go outside and try to recreate what you see. This could be your street or fields. Maybe find a picture of a landscape you like and try to recreate it.

Record yourself speaking Spanish and listen back. Can you learn some Spanish words to share with us in class?

Humanities

1. Create a poster promoting awareness of climate change and what we could do. Add facts you have learnt.
2. Create your own PowerPoint about different types of natural disasters. Which ones have occurred over the last ten years? What impact did they have on humanity?
3. Research about Mayan's popular game “pok-ta-pok”. Write an instruction guide on how to play this game.

1. Film your own movie trailer for the book and email it to us to show to the class!
2. Film yourself acting out a scene from the book.
3. Read a favourite book and write a book review!
4. Visit the local library and read a new book!
