



A 'soft c' makes an /s/ sound.



This can mean that some words that may sound like they start with an 's' can actually begin with the letter 'c'.

If the second letter of a word that starts with an /s/ sound is an 'e', 'i' or 'y', the sound could in fact be made with a 'c'!
