the English?



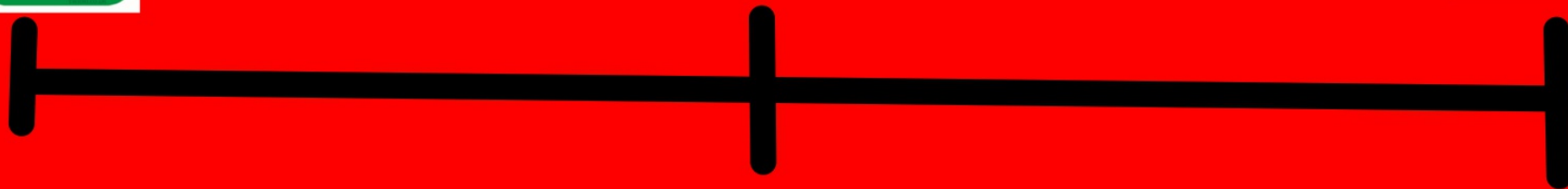

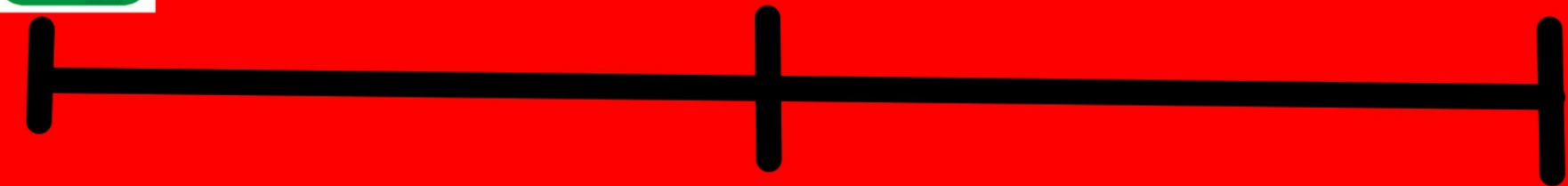
Order the time line sheets (find on our class page) in chronological order. Either write down the dates or print to cut and stick.
