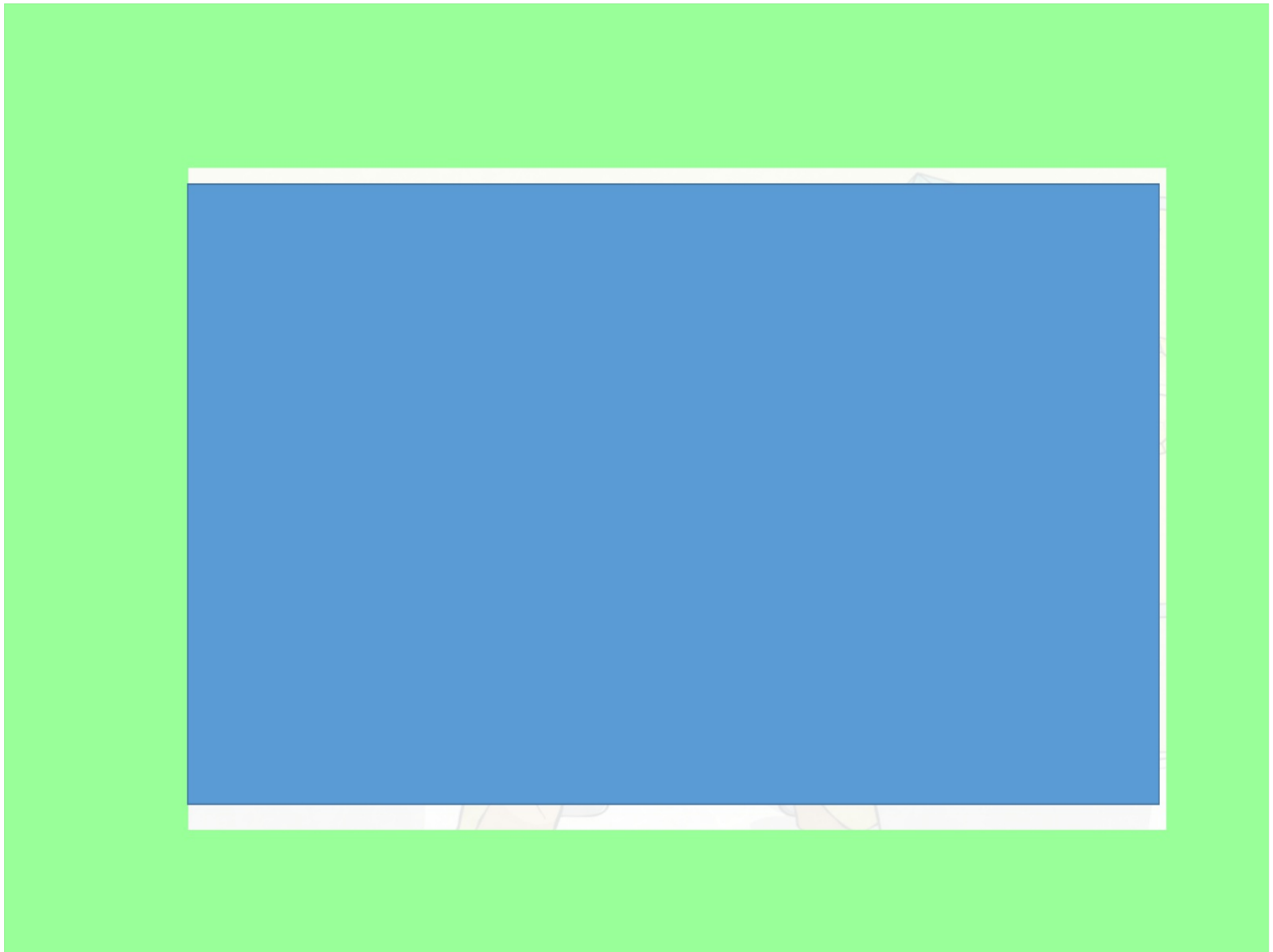

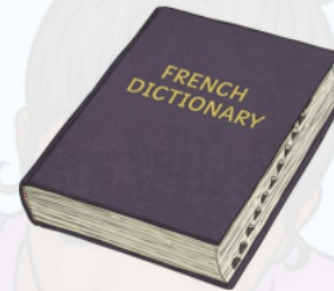

What do these words have in common?

What suffix do they all end with?

Is there any change to the root word?





If the root word doesn't end in 'e', then no change is needed  
when **-ation** is added,

e.g. inform + ation = information.

If the root word ends in 'e' (but not 'ate'), then drop the 'e'  
when **-ation** is added,

e.g. create + ation = creation.

If the root word ends in 'ate', then drop the 'ate' when **-ation**  
is added,

e.g. radiate + ation = radiation.
