

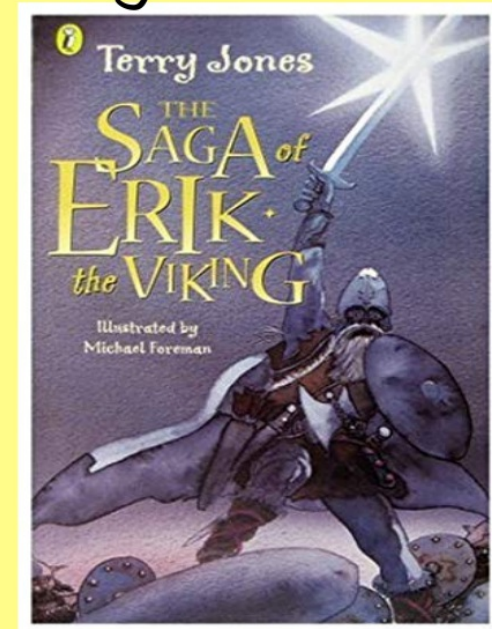

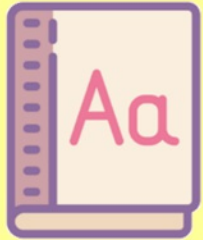

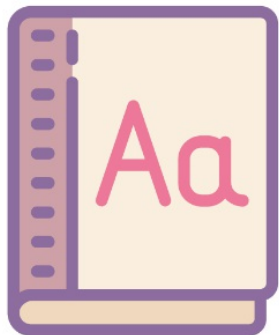
## Thorkhild and the Starsword P50 -55
