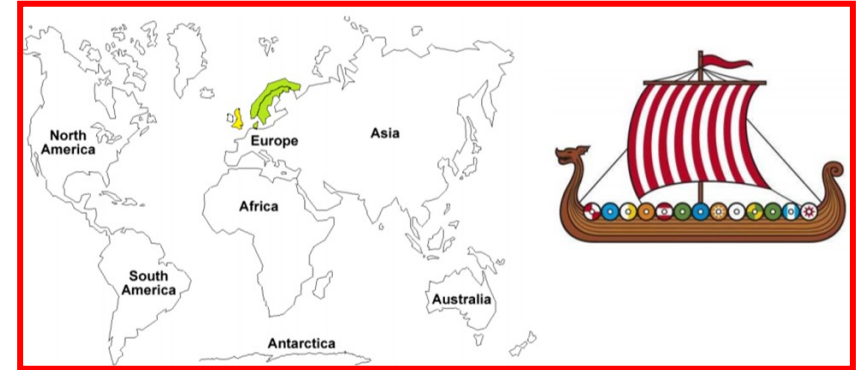

1	King Alfred the Great (847-899)	Well known for his victories against the Vikings.
2	King Athelstan	Athelstan was King of the Anglo-Saxons from 924 to 927 and King of the English from 927 to 939 when he died.
