Year 2	<u>Explore & Draw</u> Introducing the idea that artists can be collectors & explorers as they develop drawing and composition skills.	<u>Expressive Painting</u> Explore how painters sometimes use paint in an expressive and gestural way. Explore colour mixing and experimental mark making to create abstract still lifes.	<u>Stick Transformation Project</u> Explore how you can transform a familiar object into new and fun forms.

Year 3	<u>Gestural Drawing with Charcoal</u> Making loose, gestural drawings with charcoal, and exploring drama and performance.	<u>Working with Shape and Colour</u> "Painting with Scissors": Collage and stencil in response to looking at artwork.	<u>Telling Stories Through Drawing & Making</u> Explore how artists are inspired by other art forms – in this case how we make sculpture inspired by literature and film.
Year 4	<u>Storytelling Through Drawing</u> Explore how artists create sequenced drawings to share and tell stories. Create accordion books or comic strips to retell poetry or prose through drawing.	<u>Exploring Still Life</u> Explore artists working with the genre of still life, contemporary and more traditional. Create your own still life inspired art work.	<u>The Art of Display</u> Explore how the way we display our work can affect the way it is seen.
Year 5	<u>Typography & Maps</u> Exploring how we can create typography through drawing and design, and use our skills to create personal and highly visual maps.	<u>Mixed Media Land & City Scapes</u> Explore how artists use a variety of media to capture spirit of the place.	<u>Architecture: Dream Big or Small?</u> Explore the responsibilities architects have to design us a better world. Make your own architectural model.
Year 6	<u>2D Drawing to 3D Making</u> Explore how 2D drawings can be transformed to 3D objects. Work towards a sculptural outcome or a graphic design outcome.	<u>Exploring Identity</u> Discover how artists use layers and juxtaposition to create artwork which explores identity. Make your own layered portrait.	<u>Take a Seat</u> Explore how craftspeople and designers bring personality to their work.
