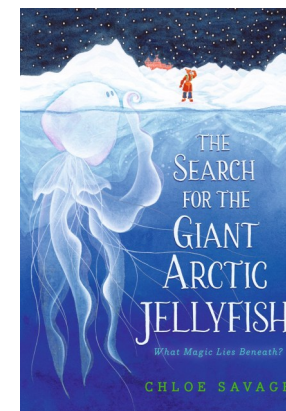
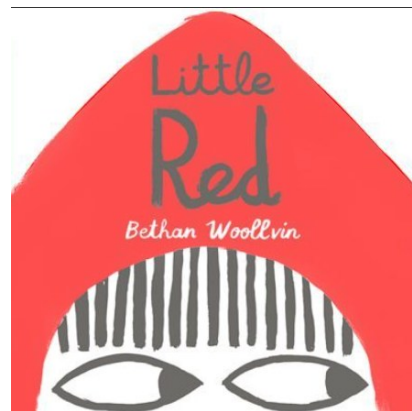

CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Year 1 Summer Term 1



I WANT MY HAT BACK



English

In English, we will begin exploring the story of 'Little Red', 'The Search for the Great Arctic Jellyfish' then 'I Want my Hat Back'. We will look at the story and practise retelling it in our own words using different resources. Then, we will think about the characters in the story and what we could change it into. Also, we will look at key sentence structure and make sure we use this in our own work. We will then aim to write our own version of the story using our own ideas. We will also change the characters in the story.

We will continue our daily guided reading sessions and our focus will be on understanding the text. Each week we will explore a new book and the key information about it.

In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on learning Phase 5 sounds and applying them to our reading and writing.

SCIENCE

We will be exploring plants and observing the plants around our school. We will identify different parts of the plants and learn their scientific names. We will also begin to identify and name different types of plants before moving to growing our own beans.

COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be exploring different types of programming technology. We will use this to programme our own animations and identify how to fix 'bugs'.

MUSIC

In Music, we will look at different music and how it makes us feel. We will also be learning how to sign different songs using Makaton.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by recapping Place Value and revise numbers up to 50. Once we are confident at this, we will move on and discuss multiplication and division. We will begin to explore different terminology linked to this and use practical resources to support our learning. When we are confident with this, we will think about the terminology linked to division and use practical resources to support our learning.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

This term, we will be providing enrichment activities through provision activities linked to our chosen texts. We will also be exploring the local area through a local area study of Ludgershall Castle.

P.E.

This term, we have two PE lessons. We will be covering Athletic skills and applying these. We will explore different athletic areas and the skills needed to be successful in each area.

HISTORY

In History, we will be looking at Castles. We will look at Ludgershall Castle (a local area castle) and discuss the history of castles.

RE

This term, we will look at Christianity. We will be focussing on the question 'How does celebrating Pentecost remind Christians that God is always with them?'.

Art

This term, the children will be exploring the art topic of 'Flora and Fauna'. We will be exploring different artwork linked to this and create our own artistic pieces.

PSHE

This term's theme is 'It's My Body'. We will learn about different aspects of Health and Wellbeing.
