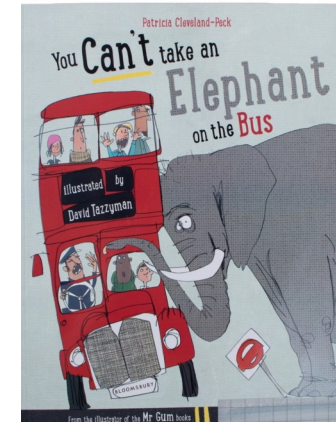
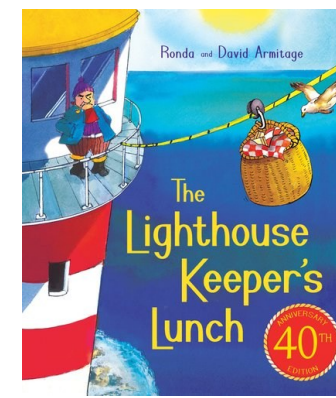

## English

In English, we will explore 4 different stories over the term. We will look at: 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch', 'La Luna', 'After Fall' and 'You can't take an elephant on the Bus'. We will look at the story and practise retelling it in our own words using different resources. Then, we will think about the characters in the story and what we could change it into. Also, we will look at key sentence structure and make sure we use this in our own work.

We will continue our daily guided reading sessions and our focus will be on understanding the text. Each week we will explore a new book and the key information about it.

In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on learning Phase 5 sounds and applying them to our reading and writing.

## SCIENCE

We will be exploring investigation through the use of stories. We will be looking at different woodland things and use this to complete our own investigations.

## COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be exploring digital writing and developing our use of a keyboard. We will also look at online safety and the topic of self-image and identify online.

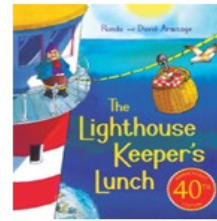
## MUSIC

## MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by recapping Place Value and revise numbers up to 50. Once we are confident at this, we will move on and discuss multiplication and division. We will begin to explore different terminology linked to this and use practical resources to support our learning. When we are confident with this, we will think about the terminology linked to division and use practical resources to support our learning.

## ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES
