We take part in PE twice a week and they will be outdoor sessions. This term your child will need trainers/PE shoes, shorts and t-shirt.

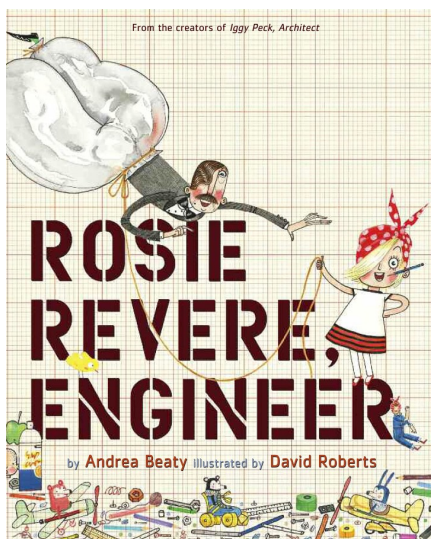
As the weather is getting warmer, please can you provide your child with: a clearly named water bottle, a waterproof coat (in case of showers) and hat/scarf if needed—thank you!

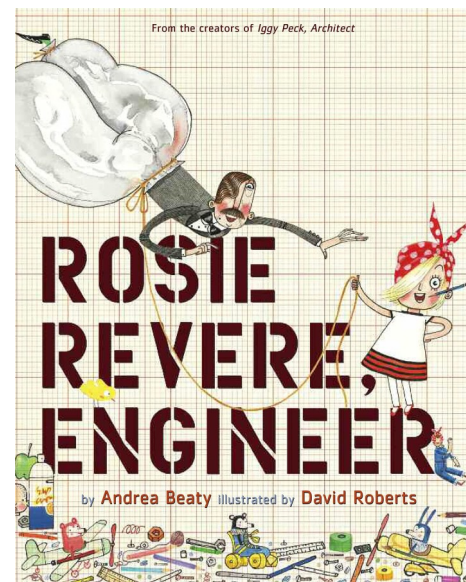

CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

English

In English, we will begin exploring the story of 'Rosie Revere Engineer' by Andrea Beaty. We will look at the story and practise retelling it in our own words using different resources. Then, we will think about the characters in the story and what we could change it into. Also, we will look at key sentence structure and make sure we use this in our own work. We will then aim to write our own version of the story using our own ideas. We will also use these stories to learn and apply new grammar focuses to extend our writing further. We will ensure we are applying this to our own versions and ensure we are using clear, controlled handwriting.

We will continue our daily Whole Class Reading sessions and our focus will be on understanding the text.

In our spelling sessions, we will explore how different spelling rules link to our previous Phonics learning.

SCIENCE

We will be consolidating our knowledge of materials and plants through different enquiries. We will look at how we can recycle different materials and use them again. We will use our scientific understanding to design a new type of plant pot.

COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be exploring how we can use technology to present data using digital pictograms. We will also think about our online safety and how we can be careful of our own security.

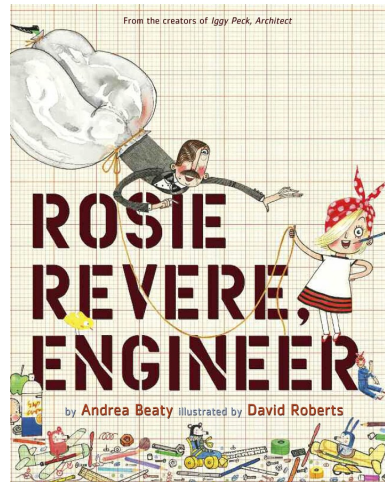
MUSIC

In Music, we will be exploring the music 'Tancymy labada'. Also, we will also be learning how to sign different songs using Makaton.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will continue to explore Fractions and explore different types of fractions. We will explore this practically, in pictures and in an abstract form. Once we have explored this, we will move on to telling the time on a digital and analogue clock to the minute. Then, we will move on to explore Statistics and finally look at position and direction.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

This term, we will providing enrichment activities through provision activities linked to our chosen texts.

P.E.

This term, we have two PE lessons. We will be covering Invasion skills and applying these. We will also be exploring our athletic skills with Coach David in our second session.
