English

In English lessons, we will explore the story 'Traction Man'. We will use the story to enhance our grammar skills, recapping using capital letters and full stops to punctuate sentences before looking at using the conjunctions 'and' and 'or' to add more information to sentences. Then we will explore expanded noun phrases to make our sentences more interesting. We will then plan and write a story about a new mission for Traction Man using all the skills we have learnt. Then we will move on to our Fiction writing where we will explore writing our own explanation text What makes a good super hero! Alongside this, the children will continue to learn comprehension and grammar skills. They will continue read to an adult every day and explore both fiction and non-fiction texts. Within class reading sessions, we will be focussing on texts which will help us to practise our comprehension skills, All of these skills will be consolidated and embedded throughout the curriculum.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, children will continue to learn how to apply their place value knowledge across all mathematical areas, particularly looking at Fractions. We will also be looking at Mass and capacity, how this is used in everyday life.

P.E

This term Monday and Friday are our PE days so children will come in to school in PE kit. The children will be working on team games in dog ball, tennis and gymnastics continue working on their sharing, turn taking and peer encouragement.

Geography

We will be exploring and looking at the North Mexico this term. The children will learning about Human and Physical Geography of Mexico city and Buenos Aires. To Comparing the economic activity and trade culture of Mexico City and Buenos Aires.

Science

This term our scientific topic is properties of materials. The children will learn about properties of everyday materials and the reversible and irreversible changes to them. We will carry out experiments showing scientific knowledge and evidence to inform our predictions and findings.

PSHE

The theme for PSHE this term is 'We are a team'. We will explore different team games and activities to develop our social skills and team building through engaging activities and interactive learning experiences.

RE

Computing
