### English

In English, we will begin exploring the warning tale called 'Emerald Forest'. We will learn the story and re-enact it in different ways using masks and puppets. Once we have done this, we will retell the story in our own words. We will focus on poetry this term and focus on onomatopoeia and applying this to writing our own poems. We will then write our own versions of the story.

Alongside this, the children will continue to learn comprehension and grammar skills. They will continue read to an adult every day and explore both fiction and non-fiction texts. Within class reading sessions, we will be focussing on texts which will help us to practise our comprehension skills. All of these skills will be consolidated and embedded throughout the curriculum.

### Science

This term our scientific topic is Animals including humans. The children will learn about the heart rates, digestive and circulatory system of humans and animals. Factors that affect our health and investigate the relationship between heart rate and exercise on the human body.

### Computing

The children will be exploring the photography in computing this term. We will be look at cropping, editing and lighting effects. We will create photographic images in the style of Edward Weston

### Mathematics

As mathematicians, the children will continue to learn how to add and subtract across 10 and 100. We will also be looking at statistics looking at drawing and interpreting bar charts and pictograms. To use to collect and represent data in two ways.

## Summer Term 2

# Falcon Class

### PSHE

The theme for PSHE this term is 'we are brilliant. We will be exploring self expression and developing a sense of identify to feel valued and understood. by developing essential academic and social skills through engaging activities and interactive learning experiences.

### DT

In **DT**, we will be exploring food from around the world and we will be designing our meal using seasonally fruits and vegetables. We will be valuing our meals and discussing how they can be improved.

### P.E

This term Monday and Friday are our PE days so children will come in to school in PE kit. The children will be working on team games in cricket and continue working on their sharing, turn taking and peer encouragement. We will also be working with sport coach this term looking at a variety of team sports.

### History
