

## Year 1 Spring 2 Homework Grid

This half term our topic is Local Area! We are linking as much of our work as we can to our local area.

Please ensure your child reads every day and record it in their reading record.

In addition, please choose 3 tasks from the grid below to complete. These can be done on a fortnightly basis.

We would love to see the children's work as they complete it and celebrate it in school!

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.

Go on a short walk near your home with an adult and draw a simple map showing key features such as your house, a shop, a park or a bus stop.



Look out of your window and list things you can see that help people in your local area (e.g., roads, signs, pavements, trees).



Draw a picture of your street and label the human features (e.g., houses, lampposts) and physical features (e.g., grass, sky, trees).



With an adult, find your home on an online map and talk about what is nearby. Draw one thing you noticed on the map.



Create a weather chart for one week by looking outside each day and recording what the weather is like in your local area.



Make a list of different types of transport you see around where you live (e.g., cars, bikes, buses).



Take a walk with an adult and count how many different types of homes you see: flats, houses, bungalows. Draw one type you spotted.



Choose a favourite place in your local area (e.g., park, playground) and draw a picture of it. Write one sentence about why you like it.
