
Environmental geography—human interactions with nature.

## What is geography?

Geography is the study of the Earth's landscapes, peoples, places and environments. It is, quite simply, the study of the world we live in.

#### Grid references

A grid reference indicates a location in terms of a series of vertical and horizontal grid lines identified by numbers or letters. First you read the eastings and then the northings.




#### 6-figures

6-figure grid references use 3 digits from the eastings and 3 digits from the northings. Imagine each square is split into 10 more small squares.
