### Literacy

This term, pupil will continue to explore Talk 4 Writing techniques, which are designed to enhance their writing skills through a structured and creative approach. This term, we will be using the story of Pirate Tom as a central theme to inspire their writing activities. A part of their writing journey, they will be writing short sentences that convey ideas and emotions, ensuring they start to include appropriate punctuation marks to enhance readability. We will also focus on practising their letter formation, which is crucial for developing their handwriting skills. This will involve a variety of activities, including tracing, and free writing. In addition to writing, our guided reading sessions will take place daily, where we will read a selection of books and explore different comprehension questions.

### Science

This term, our science curriculum will focus on the exciting topic of States of Matter! Children will experience that solids keep their shape and can be held and will explore lots of different liquids! Additionally they will learn that gases are all around us, invisible, move, and can fill a space.

### Design Technology

This term, the pupils will incorporate their learning on making a basic electrical circuit and construct a basic model lighthouse! They will explore different existing lighthouse models and then create and decorate their very own one!

### Mathematics

As mathematicians, children will continue to consolidate their understanding of place value and apply this knowledge across mathematical concepts, particularly within addition and subtraction. They will also explore the concept of Time and will practise measuring different amounts.

### PSHE

The Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education unit called "We are Respectful" The children will explore how respectful communication sounds and feels through basic role play games and interactive activities. In addition, we will explore physical boundaries and respecting personal space.
