



Reading at Clarendon Juniors

- During the 1st 2 weeks at the Junior School, your child will undertake a reading fluency assessment
- This gives a reading age that we match to a colour banded level (this
 is a different banding system to the Infant School)
- Children are encouraged to be more independent so will be responsible for changing their books when they have finished. Time is set aside during the day for children to go to the library and change their books when they are ready (initially this will be with an adult as they become more familiar with our library system)

Maths

- We have a Mastery approach to mathematics a 'small steps' approach to developing fluency, variation and mathematical reasoning.
- Use Times Table Rock Stars to aid acquiring fluency in multiplication facts and support home learning.
- All children will receive a login to keep at home during the first few weeks





Homework

- Given out weekly on a Friday and handed in on the following Wednesday (each child will be given an orange homework book to bring home every week)
- Spellings
 - Children are given 5-10 words to practice at home
- Times Tables
- Reading
 - Children are encouraged to read at least 5 times a week and record it in their reading journal – they earn apples on a tree for reaching specific target.





Early Days

- First day of term is Tuesday 3rd September
- Gates open at 8.40am and school starts at 8.45am
- Please meet your child's class teacher on the lower playground (next to the Infant playground)
- At the end of the day the teachers will bring the children out to meet you at 3.15pm on the lower playground.

After the first few days, children will then walk up the paths and come into class on their own through the conservatories

- Newsletters are sent home monthly. It is also on the website. It contains information, reminders and news.
- Please ensure the school has your updated contact details should any numbers change.
