


Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Angles	Tribes from modern day Denmark.
Christianity	A religion based on the teachings of Jesus.
Invasion	An instance of invading a country or region with an armed force.
Missionary	A person from a religion sent to spread the faith.
Pagan	A religion that involves worshipping many gods and goddesses.
Picts	Tribes originally from Scotland who were ‘foul’ and had a ‘lust for blood’.
Pillage	To rob a place using violence, usually in wartime.
Romans	The Romans invaded and settled in Britain for over 400 years, starting with their first successful raid in 54 BC.
Saxons	German – Dutch tribes who settled in Britain from around 450 AD.
Scots	People from Ireland, who, like the Picts, were fierce and powerful fighters.
Shields	a broad piece of metal or another suitable material, held by straps or a handle attached on one side, used as a protection against blows.

<input type="checkbox"/>	The Anglo-Saxon age in Britain was from around AD410 to 1066.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Many modern place names come from the original Anglo-Saxon name, giving clues about the original settlement. For example, -ingham means village and -wich means farm. So, Birmingham was originally an Anglo-Saxon village and Norwich was originally a farm.
<input type="checkbox"/>	In AD 597, the Pope sent a monk called Augustine to Britain to persuade the Anglo-Saxons who now lived there to become Christians.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The Anglo-Saxons were very superstitious. They believed in magic spells, lucky charms and dragons.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Most Anglo-Saxons were farmers. Families lived in small villages and grew produce on the land around them
<input type="checkbox"/>	Most Anglo-Saxon homes only had one room - people worked, ate and slept in one place.
