

## Year 1 Summer 1 Homework Grid

This half term our topic is 'Plants'! We are linking as much of our work as we can to the story.

Please ensure your child reads every day and record it in their reading record.

In addition, please choose 3 tasks from the grid below to complete. These can be done on a fortnightly basis.

We would love to see the children's work as they complete it and celebrate it in school!

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.

Go on a walk and find **five different plants** (grass, tree, flower, weed, bush).  
Children draw or list what they find.



Collect safe fallen leaves.  
Sort them by **size, shape, or colour**.



Choose a plant in the home, garden or local to you.  
Draw it **each day for a week** and notice any changes.



Find a plant and label the parts in a drawing:  
root, stem, leaf, flower (if visible).



Find **three trees** outside.  
Children gently touch the bark and describe it using **texture words** (bumpy, rough, smooth).



Find items outdoors and decide which are **living, once living, or never living** (e.g., leaf, stick, stone).



Look at the weather each day and think:  
**"How does this help or not help plants?"**  
Children record ideas using drawings or simple sentences.



Collect **only fallen** natural items such as petals, leaves, sticks, or seeds.  
Children arrange them into a **plant shape** (root, stem, leaves, flower) and glue or draw around them.
