Go outside and collect some leaves. Look at their colours, shapes, and sizes. Can you sort them into piles: big, small, red, yellow, brown?

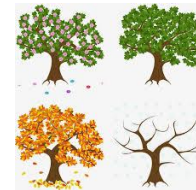


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Take some leaves, bark, or pinecones and put them under a piece of paper. Use crayons to rub over them and see the patterns appear. Can you draw or write what you notice about the textures?



Research what signs of Autumn and Winter there are.



Make a chart for the week and each day draw the weather—sunny, cloudy, rainy, or windy. Can you write the day's name next to your picture?



Go for a walk and look for things in autumn colours: red, orange, yellow, or brown. Draw a picture of what you found and label the colours!



Collect 5–10 leaves and count them. Can you make groups by colour? Try adding or taking away some leaves—how many do you have now?



Draw a picture of something you love about autumn—like raking leaves, pumpkins, or windy days. Then write a sentence about your picture.



Go outside and notice what you can see, hear, feel, and smell in autumn. When you get home, draw or write about your favourite thing from the walk.
