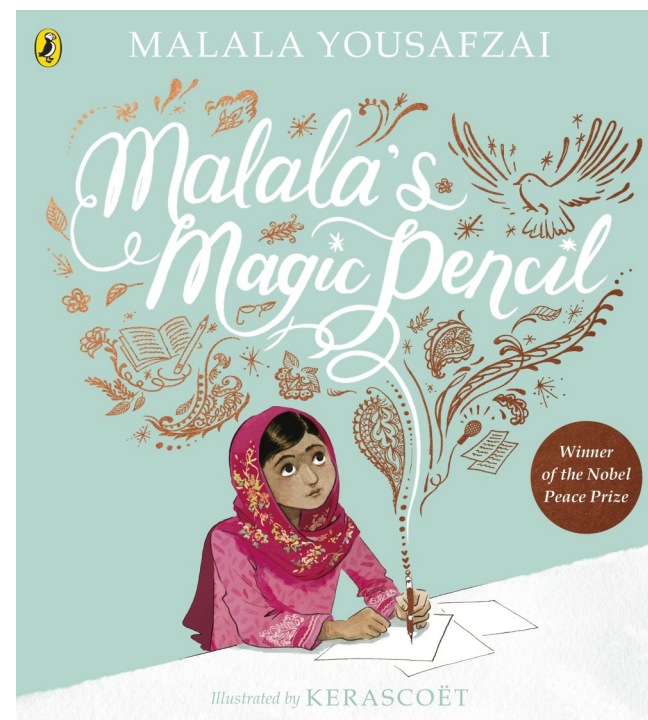

CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Year 1 Spring Term 1



English

In English, we will be exploring the story of 'Malala's Magic Pencil'. We will use the story as a stimulus for our own writing and explore all the amazing things we could do with a magic pencil! We will explore the story and retell it in our own words. Then, we will use the story as context to learn and apply different grammar points to our own writing. We will then develop our editing skills as a class and apply everything we have learnt to our own magic pencil stories.

Also, we will start our daily guided Reading sessions and our initial focus will be making sure we all point to the words as we read.

In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on revising and consolidating Phase 5.

SCIENCE

In Science this term, we will be thinking about the topic 'materials'. We will explore different materials and identify their properties. Next, we will compare these materials and discuss the jobs they may work well for.

COMPUTING

We explore how we can use different programmes to complete our own digital paintings. We will use different skills to develop our paintings further.

MUSIC

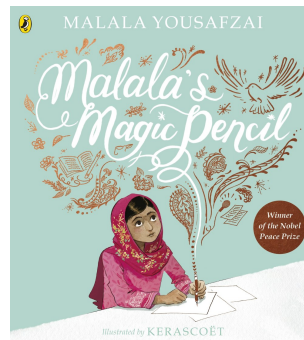
In Music, we will be exploring the Sing Up scheme. We will focus on 'Football' and exploring music linked to this theme.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by developing our understanding of place value, working with numbers up to 20. We will work on addition by focusing on small steps such as adding by counting on (starting with the largest number), finding and making numbers as well as adding by making 10. We will then move on to subtraction and learn different strategies for taking away, focusing on learning how to take away when the number crosses 10 eg 14-6.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

This term, we will be focusing on settling into our new class. Our classrooms and outdoor areas will be full of exciting activities linked to our theme.

P.E.

RE
