In English, we are focusing on using capital letters and full stops correctly and using <u>and</u> to extend our sentences. Our writing will be inspired by Lila and the Secret of Rain and The Little Polar Bear. Imagine you are visiting Lila in Kenya or Lars in the Arctic. Write a diary of things you might do together each day. 	In maths, we are focusing on place value and learning to say how many tens and ones numbers to 100 have and learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s to 100. Write the 2s, 5s or 10s numbers to 100 on little pieces of paper. Spread them around the floor. Can you jump on them in order? 	In science, we are learning about living things and their habitats. One of the habitats we are learning about is a woodland habitat. Go for a walk in a woods, near your house and take photos of all the different plants and animals you can find there. 	In geography, we are learning about the continents and where the hot and cold countries of the world are. Imagine you are visiting a hot or cold country. Write a postcard to your family telling them what it is like. 
In art, we are using clay to make a clay house. What could you make a 3D house of? You could try Lego, sticks, biscuit dough or recyclable materials. 	In PE, we are focusing on basic skills – running, jumping, skipping and hopping and skipping with a rope. What skill could you practice at home or in the park? 	In PSHE, we are thinking about our feelings and being a good friend. Draw a picture of all the things that make you feel happy and talk about it with a grown up at home. 	In computing, we are learning about how we use IT at school and in the wider world. Make a list of all the IT you see in a day and say what each is being used for.
