CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Year 2 Spring Term 1



English

In English, we will be exploring the story of 'Man on the Moon' We will use the story as a stimulus for our own writing and explore the busy day Bob has working on the moon! We will explore the story and retell it in our own words. Then, we will use the story as context to learn and apply different grammar points to our own writing. We will then develop our editing skills as a class and apply everything we have learnt to our own magic pencil stories.

Also, we will start our daily whole class reading sessions and our initial focus will be making sure we all point to the words as we read.

In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on revising and consolidating Phase 5. Then, we will move onto learning new spelling rules and applying these in our work.

SCIENCE

In Science this term, we will be thinking about the topic 'Uses of Everyday Materials'. We will apply our understanding of different materials and identify how these materials are used in the real world.

COMPUTING

We explore how we can use programming to programme a robot. We will explore how to create our own algorithm and ensure these have 'bugs' fixed.

MUSIC

In Music, we will be exploring the Sing Up scheme. We will focus on 'Grandma Rap' and exploring music linked to this theme.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by developing our understanding of multiplication and division. We will begin by recognising equal groups and developing our vocabulary surrounding equal. As the term progresses, we will then begin to look at our times tables. We will then apply our understanding of groups to division and sharing. Then, we will begin to divide by 2, 5 and 10.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES
