CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

**Year 2
Spring Term 2
2026**



English

In English, we will begin exploring the story of 'Ocean meets Sky'. We will learn the key parts of the story and immerse ourselves in the text. Once we have done this, we will focus on short burst writing tasks linked to the story. Within these tasks, we will be focusing on full stops and capital letters. We will then apply our understanding of SPaG to our sentences using different conjunctions.

Also, we will continue our daily guided reading sessions and our initial focus will be making sure we all point to the words as we read. Each week we will explore a new book and the key information about it. In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on developing alternative sounds in Letters and Sounds Phase 5. Then we will start to explore different spelling rules in Phase 6 and applying them to our work.

SCIENCE

Our focus this term, is to look at plants and their features. We will complete practical enquiries to explore the different parts of a plant. We will compare seeds and bulbs and discuss their differences. Also, we will plant our own seeds and discuss how they grow.

COMPUTING

We will start our Computing work by focussing on using different technology to create digital photographs.

MUSIC

In Music, we will continue to follow our music scheme Sing Up. We will be focussing on 'The Train Song' and 'Orawa'.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will continue to develop our understanding of multiplication and division. We will begin by recognising equal groups and developing our vocabulary surrounding equal. . Then, we will move on and look at block diagrams. After this, we will explore the properties of different shapes.

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ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

This term, we will be providing enrichment activities linked to World Book Day. We will also be completing different activities linked to our Science theme.

P.E.

This term, we have two PE lessons. Our Wednesday PE lesson is led by Coach David. This term he will be focusing on ball skills. In our second PE session, we will be looking at developing our ball skills and we will apply this to games.

RE

This term, we will be exploring the religion of Christianity. We will be answering the question 'What are the best symbols of Jesus' death and resurrection at Easter?' We will explore what a symbol is and the different symbols which relate to Easter.

GEOGRAPHY

We will explore simple compass directions and use this to explore maps. Then, we will apply this to our directional language and explore aerial photographs.

ART

In art we will explore how we can use paint to show expression. We will explore the artists Van Gogh and Cezanne. After this, we will create our own pieces inspired by their work.

PSHE

This term's theme is 'Digital Wellbeing' and we will explore how relationships are. We will use this to explore relationships.
