LITERACY

This term, the children's writing will be inspired by the book, Migrants by Issa Watanabe. We will write a mixture of genres including narrative and diary entries. As a continuation of previous terms, the children will investigate spelling patterns and apply them in their writing.

Reading and understanding texts, in particular the use of inference, will continue to be the focus this Summer term.

SCIENCE

In Science the children will be learning about 'Animals including Humans'. During this topic we will be exploring how to keep healthy, including our teeth and understand how our digestive system works.

COMPUTING
