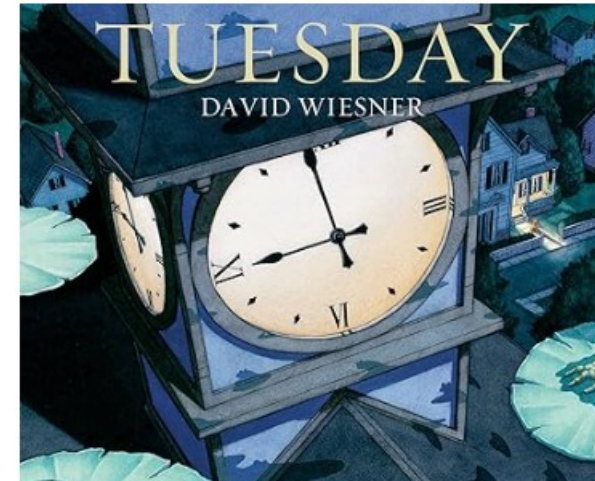

## LITERACY

This term, the children's writing will be inspired by the book, Tuesday by David Wiesner. We will write a mixture of genres including narrative and diary entries. As a continuation of previous terms, the children will investigate spelling patterns and apply them in their writing.

Reading and understanding texts, in particular the use of inference, will continue to be the focus this Summer term.

## SCIENCE

In Science, we will undertake a unit called 'Making Connections'. We will recall key knowledge from previous units and apply this knowledge in new contexts.

## COMPUTING

This term, the children will continue to develop their programming skills using Scratch. They will follow various instructions to programme and develop a game that can be played.

## PSHE

We will identify parts of the body that males and females have in common and those that are different. We will learn and explore why puberty happens.

## Modern Foreign Languages

The children will further develop their French vocabulary and practise their conversational skills. This term will focus on holidays and hobbies.

## MATHEMATICS

In mathematics we will continue to develop our skills in:

- Statistics
- Shape and Space
- Position and Direction
- Time

We will continue to develop our fluency in the times tables up to 12 x 12.

# Summer Term 2 2026 Year 4

## Geography

The children will further develop their Geographical skills and knowledge. They will focus their studies on the physical and human features of Paris, France. The children will consider the differences and similarities between Paris and London.

## Homework

The children will continue to receive spellings each week, please support them in completing the activities. Children are also required to log onto TTRS to practise their times tables regularly.

## P.E.

During this term, the children will be participating in rounders, developing their batting and fielding skills. We will also be continuing swimming once a week on Fridays.

## DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

We will try out our baking skills this term by planning and making a French style biscuit. This will link with our Geography unit.

## RE

In RE, we will be looking at Sikhism. Our key questions is 'How do Sikhs put their beliefs about equality into practice?'

This term, we will continue to learn to play the recorder. We will develop our skills to play a tune!
