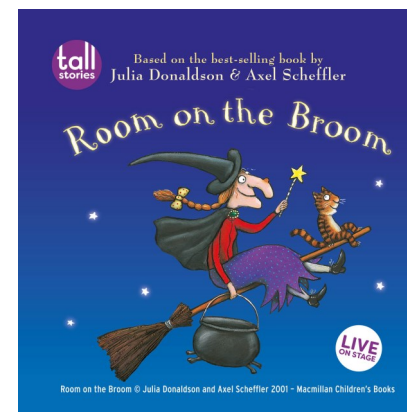

'Marvellous Magic'



English

In English, we will begin exploring the story of 'Room on the Broom'. We will look at the story and practise retelling it in our own words using different resources. Then, we will think about the characters in the story and what we could change it into. Also, we will look at key sentence structure and make sure we use this in our own work. We will then aim to write our own version of the story using our own ideas. We will also change the characters in the story.

We will continue our daily guided reading sessions and our focus will be on understanding the text. Each week we will explore a new book and the key information about it.

In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on learning alternative sounds in Twinkl Phonics Level 5. We will learn to sound and blend four and five letter words using sounds we already know.

SCIENCE

We will continue to look at the four seasons and think about the changes from Spring to Summer. We will look for signs of summer and conduct enquiries about these. Also, we will continue to look at plants. We will identify our senses and which body part is associated with each sense. We will also analyse sense data.

COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be exploring different types of technology in the world around us and how they are used. We will then explore how we can use technology to gather and record data in different ways through different programmes.

MUSIC

In Music, we will look at different music and how it makes us feel. We will also be learning how to sign different songs using Makaton.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by recapping Place Value and revise numbers up to 50. Once we are confident at this, we will move on and discuss multiplication and division. We will begin to explore different terminology linked to this and use practical resources to support our learning. When we are confident with this, we will think about the terminology linked to division and use practical resources to support our learning.

Spring Term 2 2025 Year 1

THEME: 'Marvellous Magic'

PSHE

This term's theme is 'Relationships'. We will learn about different relationships.

HOMEWORK

Spelling books are sent home on a Friday. The children will be given a list of spelling words to learn and practise in their spelling book. Please read at home daily with your child either from their home reading book or a book you have at home to share.

P.E.

This term, we have two PE lessons. Our Thursday PE lesson is led by Coach David. This term, he will be focusing on bat and ball skills. In our second PE session, we will be covering Athletic skills and applying these.

GEOGRAPHY

This term we will be looking at the local area and its features. We will use our map reading skills to complete a local area walk and identify the features around us.

RE

This term, we will look at Christianity. We will be focussing on the question 'Why do Christians pray to God to worship him?' We will explore different prayer and why they are important to Christians.

DT

This term, the children will be exploring cooking in their DT sessions. We will explore different fruit and develop our cutting skills. We will create our own final piece of a fruit kebab.
