

<u>English</u>

In English, we will start to develop our 'Talk for Writing' story making skills by learning to retell the story of 'Pirate Tom'. This story is about a pirate who travels all over the world! We will become familiar with the text before changing parts of the story to make our own new story. We will also think about the settings and learn how to describe them. Then, we will focus on the non-fiction text type of explanation. We will explain how different things work using key sills.

Also, we will start our daily Guided Reading sessions where we will focus on decoding and understanding the text. We will then complete different activities linked to the text whilst in small groups.

In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on revising and consolidating our Level 6 Phonics. This will allow us to become secure in our sounds and apply this to different areas of our learning without the support of an adult.

SCIENCE

In Science this term, we will be focussing on the topic of 'Scientists and Inventors'. Throughout the term, we will think about different scientists and how their inventions has changed Science.

COMPUTING

We will start our Computing work by focussing on using computers safely and following our rules. We will explore how to use programmes to develop simple pictograms and present data.

MUSIC

In Music, we will focus on the theme of Carnival of the Animals through our Sing Up Scheme.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by developing our addition and subtraction skills. We will then apply these to different questions and develop our reasoning. Once we have become secure in this, we will move towards measurement. During our measurement unit, we will look at money and develop our skills linked to this. We will recognise, compare and sort money. Also, we will be using our new 'APE' questioning skills — Answer it, Prove it, Explain it. In our lessons, we will also develop key counting skills. This term, we have two PE lessons. Our Wednesday PE lesson is led by Coach David. This term, we will be focussing on dance. We will create our own dance using pathways and levels to interest the audience.

<u>RE</u>

This term, we will be focussing on the religion of Christianity. We will be exploring the question — Why was Jesus given the name savior?

<u>HISTORY</u>

This term, we will be thinking about people through history and the impact they had. We will focus on Mary Seacole and how she was an important person in History.

DT

In DT, we will explore ways we can create
