<u>Homework</u>

Year 2 homework is reading and spellings. Spellings are set on a weekly basis. For more information, please read the information on the front and back of the red spelling book. Children are tested on their spellings on a Friday at the back of their spelling books.

<u>PE</u>

We take part in PE twice a week and if the weather allows they will be outdoor sessions. This term, your child will need shorts, tracksuit bottoms (in case of cold weather) and a t-shirt.


Outdoor Environment:

<u>English</u>

In English, we will begin exploring the traditional tale called 'Kassim and the Greedy Dragon'. We will learn the story and re-enact it in different ways using masks and puppets. Once we have done this, we will retell the story in our own words. We will focus on developing our understanding of SPaG terminology and applying this to our own writing. We will then write our own versions of the story.

Also, we will continue our daily guided reading sessions and our initial focus will be making sure we all point to the words as we read. Each week we will, explore a new book and the key information about it. In our Phonics sessions, we will focus on developing alternative sounds in Level 5 using Twinkl Phonics. Then we will start to explore different spelling rules in Level 6 and applying them to our work.

SCIENCE

Our focus this term, is to look at materials and the different properties they have. We will then explore how materials can be changed by exerting force on them. This could be from: squeezing, pushing, pulling, twisting, etc. The children will be able to explore this practically using different materials.

COMPUTING

We will start our Computing work by focussing on using computers safely and following our rules. We will learn how to programme simple algorithms. Then, we will look at Google Maps.

MUSIC

This term, we will be exploring the Grandma Rap!

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will begin by developing our understanding of multiplication and division. We will begin by recognising equal groups and developing our vocabulary surrounding equal. As the term progresses, we will then begin to look at our times tables. We will then apply our understanding of groups to division and sharing. Then, we will begin to divide by 2, 5 and 10.

Spring Term 1 2025 Year 2 THEME: 'Exciting Explorers'

This term, we have two PE lessons. Our Thursday PE lesson is led by Coach David. This term he will be focusing on gymnastic skills. In our second PE session, we will also be looking at developing our gymnastic skills.

<u>RE</u>

This term, we will be exploring the religion of Islam. We will be answering the question 'How do some Muslims show Allah is compassionate and merciful ?" We will explore this and find ways to show this.

HISTORY

We will explore the history of the moon landings and how they are globally significant. Through this, we will also explore key people who landed on the moon.

<u>HOMEWORK</u>

Spelling books are sent home on a Friday. The children will be given a list of spelling words to learn and practise in their spelling book. Please read at home daily with your child either from their home reading book or a book you have at home to share.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

This term, we will be providing enrichment activities in the outdoor areas. We will also be exploring different stories and sharing these with our peers.

<u>ART</u>

In art we will explore how we can use paint to show expression. We will explore the artists Van Gogh and Cezanne. After this, we will create our own pieces inspired by their work.

<u>PSHE</u>

This term's theme is 'Dreams and Goals.' We will learn about having a positive attitude and how to keep trying even when something is difficult.

<u>P.E.</u>
