Age 5 learning outcomes: the learning outcomes below are summative and demonstrate what pupils should have covered in religious education.

YFS Learning Outcomes

Understand

1. Know that *God* made the world and everything in it.
2. Know that *God* made each person and loves them.
3. Hear and retell stories about *Jesus*, *Mary*, and others from the Bible.
4. Recognise that prayer is a way of talking to *God*.
5. Know that the Church celebrates special times like Christmas and Easter.
6. Recognise symbols used in prayer and liturgy (e.g., candles, Advent wreath, ashes).
7. Know that the Bible is a special book for Christians.
8. Know that Christians belong to a Church family.

Discern

1. Talk about what they wonder about in stories from the Bible.
2. Ask questions about *God*, *Jesus*, and the world.
3. Respond to stories through art, music, movement, and play.
4. Explore how Christians show love and care for others.

Respond

1. Share their thoughts and feelings about what they've learned.
2. Join in with simple prayers and songs.
3. Reflect on how they can care for others and the world.
4. Celebrate special times with joy and reverence.
