### Adapting to the New Normal

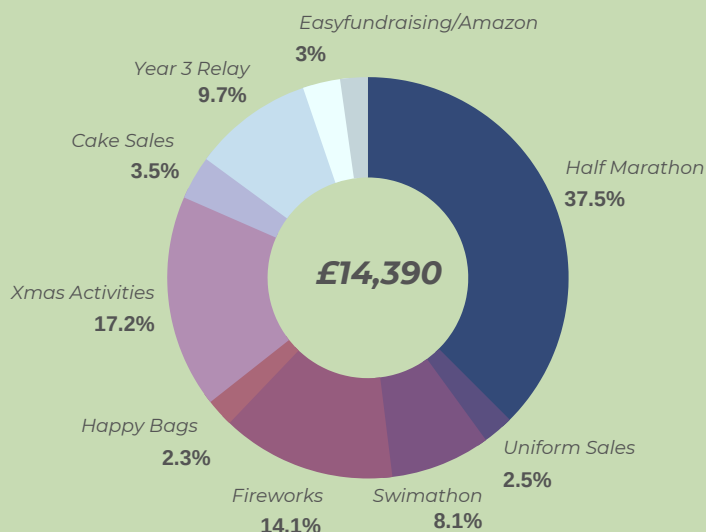
